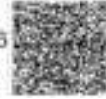
By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
06	30.01.2025	115 (2) (323 of IPC), 118 (1) (324 IPC), 191 (3) (148 of IPC), 190 (149 of IPC), 351 (3) (506 of IPC) of BNS, 2023.	Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 03.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 03.04.2025.

3. Learned State counsel intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 03.04.2025, following order was passed:

“ Heard.

2. It is inter alia contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that during the pendency of the petition, the matter has been settled. He further contends that even otherwise, as per the allegations, only simple injuries have been attributed to the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has categorically stated at Bar that he has specific instructions from the complainant to submit that the matter has been compromised and he has no objection if concession of bail is granted to the petitioner.

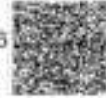
4. Learned State counsel on the basis of pairvi report has confirmed that as per the allegations, the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature.

5. Be it the case, without commenting on the merits, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

6. List on 30.04.2025.

7. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present in Court along with record on that date. ”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 03.04.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 03.04.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by

way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
