1. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court and was on bail in case FIR No. 139, dated 03.09.2019, under Sections 21 (1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 and Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur. However, the petitioner got absent on one date, i.e. on 09.04.2025 due to some urgent domestic work. The petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court.
