SUDHIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petition herein, inter alia, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the new voter list prepared on the basis of new Ward Bandi done by the delimitation board.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners would be satisfied, in case, their pending representation dated 22.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) is decided by respondent No.3 / concerned authority i.e. District Election Officer-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears and opposes issuance of notice of motion. He submits that grievance of the petitioners will be looked into by respondent No.2 / concerned authority and it shall take decision either way, on pending



representation dated 22.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioners. He ensures that the decision will be taken at the earliest.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 / concerned authority to consider pending representation dated 22.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioners and pass an appropriate reasoned order, in accordance with law, at the earliest, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy / production of this order.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
