1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon respondent no.3, to upgrade the Aadhar Card (Annexure P-4), and to rectify the date of birth of the present petitioner, which, as per the petitioner wrongly, entered in the said Aadhar Card. He further seeks a direction to respondent no.3 to decide his representation dated 09.12.2024 (Annexure P-7).

2. Learned counsel for respondents no.1 to 3, who has caused appearance on an advance notice, through virtual mode, fairly submits that the representation dated 09.12.2024 (Annexure P-7), moved by the

present petitioner can be decided by respondent no.3, in a time bound manner.

3. In view of the above, this Court deems it appropriate to **dispose of** the instant petition, with a direction to respondent no.3 to decide the representation (Annexure P-7), by passing a speaking order, after giving an adequate opportunity to hearing to the petitioner, within a period of one month from today.

4. In case of any dereliction on the part of respondent no.3, in not deciding the said representation within the above stipulated time period, the petitioner is at liberty to revive the instant petition, by making an apt motion.

5. Learned counsel for respondents no.1 to 3, undertakes to inform respondent no.3, regarding the aforesaid order.
