**SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)**

This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate protection to the petitioners and also directing the private respondents not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioners.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Gurwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Police Sub Division Ajnala, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of the State, the same is taken on record. Along with the status report, statements of petitioners No. 1 and 2 have been annexed as Annexure R-1/T and R-2/T.

Counsel for the petitioner disputes the statements annexed with the status report stating that these statements have not been rendered by the petitioners.



Since the disputed facts have been emerged out during the course of the hearing, in light of the notification No.HOME-HM-4040SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch), the petitioner is relegated to the alternate remedy granted by that notification whereby their grievance would be considered and representation would be adjudicated after examining the allegations made qua false statements produced by the DSP, Ajnala by passing a speaking order.

The petition is therefore dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to approach the authorities as has been referred to in the notification dated 23.01.2025.
