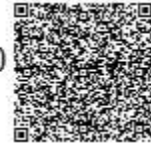

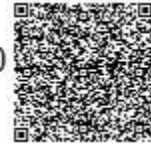

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 15 dated 23.03.2025, under Section 85 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Mohali (Annexure P-1).
2. Vide order dated 17.06.2025, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karam Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial

interrogation is no longer required as the recoveries have already been effected.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that there are certain additional issues which have been raised by the complainant which are not been looked into by the Investigating Agency.

5. Learned State counsel submits that the challan has yet not been presented and the Authorities will look into the same in accordance with law.

6. In light of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 17.06.2025 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 482 of BNSS, 2023.

7. However, nothing stated above shall be construed as a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

8. It is made clear that, in case, the petitioner is found involved in any such activity once again, the present concession granted shall automatically stand vacated.

9. It is further made clear that this order shall not be construed as parity *qua* any other co-accused.
