These are petitions under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The parties had entered into a contract which contains an arbitration clause. Disputes and differences have arisen between the parties. It is agreed that the disputes are to be referred to arbitration.

3. The petitions are, therefore, disposed of by appointing Mr. B.R. Bansal, a retired Additional District and Sessions Judge, Punjab, as the sole arbitrator. The fees shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators' Fees) Rules, 2014. The venue shall be the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre.
