Compliance report by way of an affidavit of Ms. Anupma Malik, Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram has been filed on behalf of respondents as per which, the petitioner has been issued allotment letter dated 28.04.2025 with respect to residential plot No.1348-B in Sector-51 Gurugram against oustee quota for a plot measuring 406 square metres.

Learned counsel for the respondents undertake to hand over the actual physical possession of the plot in question within a period of 7 days from today,

In view thereof, no cause survives in the present petition and the same is thus, disposed of.

The respondents undertake to hand over the actual physical possession of the plot however, in case the petitioner feels aggrieved of the price fixation by the respondents, he shall be at liberty to avail his remedies in accordance with law.

In case, respondents fail to abide by the aforesaid undertaking, 1/3<sup>rd</sup> salary of Estate Officer, Gurugram shall remain attached till the compliance with respect to handing over of actual physical possession is made.
