Jagdish Vs. Inder Pal and others

Present:- None for the appellant.

Mr.Sanjeev Kodan, Advocate for the respondent-Insurance Company.

On the last 3-4 dates, none appeared for the appellant.

On 29.11.2024, when none had put in appearance on behalf of the appellant, notice was issued to the appellant and his counsel to appear before the Bench on 18.12.2024. As per office report, notice could not be served upon the appellant for want of complete address and when the counsel for the appellant also failed to put in appearance on 18.12.2024, a specific notice was sent to him stating that in case he fails to appear on the next date of hearing, appropriate order to consign the appeal will be passed.

Today also, none has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant. As per office report, notice alongwith the order dated 18.12.2024 was sent to the counsel for the appellant, which was served through his Clerk. Despite service, none is present on behalf of the appellant.

It is an injury case and when the appeal was filed, it was time- barred and application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal

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is still pending. As per findings given by MACT in its award dated 28.05.2015, permanent disability has not been proved on record.

In view of the above, it appears that the appellant has lost interest in pursuing the appeal. Accordingly, the appeal is disposed of and the file is consigned to the record room with liberty to get it revived by making appropriate application as and when desired.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
