Fresh memo of appearance has been filed on behalf of respondent No.4-Insurance Company, which is taken on record.

2. It is claimant's appeal for enhancement in the compensation amount.

3. A perusal of the Award would reveal that the injured-claimant sustained two simple injuries. Only an amount of ₹2,540/- was found to have been spent for purchasing the medicines. There was no permanent disability. The Tribunal has awarded compensation of ₹7,500/- to the claimant-injured. This Court does not find any ground for any enhancement qua the compensation.

As such, finding the present appeal to be devoid of any merit, the same is hereby dismissed.
