The writ petition bearing CWP No.25052 of 2012 filed by the petitioners, seven in number, was allowed vide judgment dated 28.01.2016 (**Annexure P-1**), passed by learned Single Judge of this Court. It was directed that the previous service rendered by the petitioners with Haryana State Minor Irrigation Tubewell Corporation (for short "HSMITC") was to count towards the entire length of service rendered by the petitioners for the purpose of grant of the benefit of ACP Scale of Rs.7500-13000 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

By way of CM No.7642-CII of 2017, the respondents have placed on record a memo dated 30.03.2017, whereby the previous service rendered by the petitioners with HSMITC towards grant of ACP Scale has been ordered to be counted. It is thus stated that the order has been complied with, although the necessary payments would be released in due course of time.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioners agrees that the aforesaid order stands complied with.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

The payment of the consequent relief would not be delayed unnecessarily.

Since the main contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous, the pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
