1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No. 4 and 5 and their accomplices in terms of the representation dated 19.03.2025 submitted by the petitioner.

2. At the very outset, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who has advance notice of the petition, has placed on record a copy of Calendra No. 53 dated 17.03.2025 and on instructions from SI Dalbir Singh has submitted that on receipt of an information on 05.03.2025 from Civil Hospital, Hansi regarding admission of the petitioner after receiving some injuries in a brawl, a police party had reached there and had conducted an inquiry, in which, it was found that the petitioner had previously gone to the shop of one Mumtaj Juli and had broken the glass of his shop. In that regard, the opposite party had gone to the house of the petitioner to make a complaint,

whereby an altercation had taken place between them. However, later on, the opposite party had threatened the petitioner. On account of the same, as a preventive measure the aforesaid Calendra under Sections 126/170 of BNSS has been registered in order to maintain law and order in the locality.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the aforesaid facts and has submitted that the present petition may be disposed of at this stage.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as no case is made out to issue any direction to the official respondents.
