1. Present petition has been filed praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.277, dated 11.09.2024, under Sections 303(2), 324(5), 329(3), 333 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana.
