Vide the instant petition, petitioner/plaintiff seeks direction to the learned Civil Judge for expeditious disposal of injunction application, which is pending adjudication for more than one year as petitioner/plaintiff filed civil suit on 05.08.2024 and along with that suit, an application for interim injunction was filed. Defendant appeared on 28.08.2024 and even since then, a period of more than one year has elapsed but application for interim stay filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC has not been decided.

2. Perusal of the interim orders passed by the learned Civil Judge shows that the suit is pending for decision of the application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC along with another application for consolidation of suits and it is regularly being adjourned on one pretext or the other. Injunction applications are required to be disposed of expeditiously and by not disposing of the injunction applications for a period of more than one year, the Civil Court has not exercised the jurisdiction vested in the Court. As such, the present petition is allowed and the learned Civil Judge is directed to dispose of



injunction application within a period of two months from the date next fixed before the Civil Court.

3. Accordingly the present petition stands disposed of. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
