**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)**

1. Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the appellant submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition at this stage. He has, however, requested that some direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously, which is already at the stage of recording of defence evidence.
2. In view of the aforesaid submission, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

3. The trial Court is, however, directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within a period of four weeks from conclusion of defence evidence. Needless to mention, the petitioner shall conclude his evidence at the earliest.
