In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to hear and decide the statutory appeal dated 14.05.2025 (Annexure P-2), alongwith the application for stay filed against punishment orders dated 12.12.2024/06.05.2025 (Annexure P-1), passed by respondent No.1, whereby the punishment of recovery has been imposed along with stoppage of one annual increment with cumulative effect.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction be given to respondent No.2 to decide the statutory appeal dated 14.05.2025 (Annexure P-2), filed by the petitioners by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

6. Since the statutory appeal is still pending and yet to be decided, it would be in the interest of justice that no further recovery shall be effected from the salary of the petitioners till the disposal of the appeal.
