The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for directing the respondents No.2 to 4 for releasing the detenué i.e. Asma from the illegal, unlawful custody of the official respondents.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of Annexures R-1 and R-2, learned State counsel would submit that the alleged detenué namely, Asma has deposed before the police authorities that she has married Ikran. The present petition came on behalf of her father, who has also lodged an FIR No.337 dated 03.11.2023 under Section 365 IPC, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, Yamuna Nagar.

In view of the statement rendered by the alleged detenué who has attained the age of majority on the date of tendering the statement



before the SDJM, Bilaspur and as per pleadings made in petition in para No.2 her date of birth is 05.03.2006 (Annexure P-1 & P-2).

In view of the above, no further interference by this Court is required and the present case has been dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
