1. By this common judgment, petitions bearing CRM-M-47520-2024 and CRM-M-53099-2024 are being decided together as the same arise out of a common FIR. For the sake of brevity facts are taken from CRM-M-47520-2024.

2. The petitioner(s) apprehending arrest in the FIR captioned above have come up before this Court under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, [BNSS], seeking anticipatory bail.

3. Counsel for the petitioner(s) have handed over the order dated 30.06.2025 as per which after investigation, the cancellation report has been presented in the Court. He further submits that the allegations against the petitioner(s) are vague and unsubstantiated. He further prays for bail by imposing any stringent conditions and contends that pre-trial incarceration would cause an irreversible injustice to the petitioner(s) and their family.

4. State counsel submits that cancellation has been recommended in this Court.
