The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking quashing of the order dated 04.02.2025, Annexure P-3, whereby the petitioner, who is working as an Assistant in the Parishad at Karnal, has been sent on deputation of six months to its office at Ambala.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is suffering from serious medical issues, and has a broken shoulder as well. This makes difficult for her to travel all the way from Karnal to Ambala every day. At this stage, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to make appropriate representation to the second respondent to re-consider the order dated 04.02.2025.

3. Learned counsel for the Parishad, appearing on advance notice, contends that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, the same will be considered sympathetically by respondent no.2-State Project Director, Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna

Parishad, and decided in accordance with law, within six weeks of receiving the representation.

4. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
