The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.39, dated 05.12.2023 under Sections 420,218,120-B,467,468,471 of IPC and Section 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, Police Station ACB Gurugram, District Anti Corruption Bureau, Haryana (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
