The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.135 dated 20.11.2022 under Section 379-B IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 07.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A short reply dated 10.09.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 07.08.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
