**VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)**

Learned counsel representing respondent No.2 submits that offer of appointment for the post of Upper Division Clerk (Common Cadre) has been issued to the petitioner vide communication dated 12.07.2025 and the petitioner has accepted the same.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only apprehension is that despite the offer of appointment, the actual letter of appointment shall not be issued in time. He submits that the previous contempt petition filed by the petitioner i.e. COCP-1532-2025 was also disposed of on 21.04.2025 on the basis of a statement given that the petitioner had been recommended for appointment to the post of Upper Division Clerk but despite the same, the offer of appointment has been issued after filing of the second contempt petition.



3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the petitioner has accepted the offer of appointment and there shall be no delay in issuing of letter of appointment once the process of verification of documents is complete.

4. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

5. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule is discharged.
