1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has filed representations (Annexures P-3 to P-6) for the preparation of the time table on the route, on which the petitioner has been granted permit to ply the bus as well as for waiving of the motor vehicle tax levied on petitioner as the petitioner is not able to ply the buses as of now. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said request is not being accepted which is causing prejudice to petitioner.

2. Learned counsel submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 17.09.2024 (Annexure P-6) and petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, that the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. T. P. S. Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 17.09.2024 (Annexure P-6), has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of three months from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
