AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 22.02.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No.4722 of 2019.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“This Court is sanguine that, if indeed, any such representation, as referred to above, is pending, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law and appropriate orders in this regard shall be passed within a week from the receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Ramandeep Singh Bains, Executive Engineer, Patiala Drainage Division, Patiala was filed annexing order dated 14.03.2019.

In view of order passed, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the said order.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
