Prayer in the present application moved on behalf of the applicant-respondent No. 3, is for preponing the date of hearing from 03.09.2025 to an earlier date.

Since, the main case itself has been listed today, present application has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

MAIN CASE

The petitioner-plaintiff, by way of present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeks setting aside of an order

dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P-8), passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Hisar (**hereinafter referred to as “Appellate Court”**) in miscellaneous appeal, whereby an order dated 13.05.2022 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hisar (**hereinafter referred to as “trial Court”**), dismissing the application under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 of The Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (**for short “CPC”**), preferred at the instance of petitioner-plaintiff, was dismissed, thereby affirming the order passed by the trial Court.

[2] This Court, while issuing notice vide order dated 15.06.2022, granted interim injunction while restraining the respondents from demolishing any part of the construction over the suit property in question.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel(s) representing the petitioner as well as respondent No. 3 are *ad idem* that the present petition may be disposed off with a request to the learned trial Court to expedite and conclude the proceedings in the suit. They further inform that the proceedings in the suit are now fixed for 10.09.2025 for rebuttal and arguments.

[4] In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the respective parties through their counsel(s), present petition is **disposed off** with a request to the learned trial Court to conclude the proceedings in the suit within two months from the next date of hearing fixed before it, i.e. 10.09.2025.

[5] Needless to say that the interim order dated 15.06.2022 passed by this Court shall remain operative till the final adjudication of the suit.

[6] It is also made clear that the aforesaid interim order dated 15.06.2022 shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the main suit for its disposal.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
