1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.93 dated 09.11.2024 registered under Sections 409, 420, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
