1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.60, dated 21.06.2024, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 of IPC and Section 326 of IPC, 1860 added later on, registered at Police Station Rahon, District SBS Nagar.

2. Vide order dated 16.10.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 16.10.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Mr. Shoryaveer Vashist, Advocate has appeared and filed his power of attorney on behalf of the complainant today in the Court and the same is taken on record. He has opposed the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Pal has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 16.10.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

7. Petition stands allowed.
