1. As common issues are involved in the captioned petitions, with the consent of both sides, the same are hereby disposed of by this common order. For the sake of brevity and convenience, facts are borrowed from *CWP-5174-2005*.



2. The petitioners through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 28.05.2003 (Annexure P-6) to the extent private respondents have been promoted as Officer Scale-I ignoring their claim.

3. Mr. Amandeep Rana, Advocate appeared and filed his Memorandum of Appearance on behalf of the petitioners. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that **CWP No.10044 of 2003, Gireesh Kumar and others v. The Government of India and others**, as mentioned in index of instant petition (CWP-11836-2003) stands disposed of. LPA No.152 of 2008 filed against order passed by learned Single Judge stands dismissed, thus, instant petition may be disposed of in same terms.

5. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petitions stand disposed of in terms of judgment passed in **Gireesh Kumar (supra)**.
