1. The present petition was filed in the year 2022 and interim order was granted vide order dated 01.04.2022 but, the correct addresses of respondents No. 3 to 6 have not been given despite various opportunities given. On 16.09.2024, the following order was passed but the correct addresses have still not been furnished, which clearly shows that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present remedy.

*“As per office report, notice could not be issued to respondents No. 3 to 6 for want of correct address.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to do the needful within 7 days.*

*On doing so, let fresh notice be issued to respondents No. 3 to 6 for 09.01.2025.*

*Till the next date of hearing, interim order to continue.”*



2. Once despite enough opportunities petitioner has not furnished the correct addresses of contesting respondents and is enjoying interim order, makes it clear that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

3. Dismissed for non-prosecution.

4. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
