**MAHESH GROVER.J.**

The order of the writ court, the non-compliance of which has been alleged by the petitioners, does not even remotely address the cause which the petitioners now espouses in the present petition regarding grant of disability pension. Deceased Naib Singh was held entitled to the benefits restricted to 38 months. Since there is no direction given by the writ court regarding the admissibility of disability pension, by no stretch of imagination can this court say that there has been non-compliance of the mandate of the writ court. The petitioners have a distinct cause of action which they are at liberty to agitate in appropriate proceedings. The contempt petition being frivolous is dismissed.
