1. In the present petition, the claim being raised by the petitioner is that the medical bills submitted by him have not been reimbursed, which is totally arbitrary and illegal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at one given point of time, on 30.01.2023 the petitioner has received an email that a sum of ₹3,03,275/- has already been released on 10.12.2020 but even the said amount has not been released, which is causing prejudice hence, respondents be directed to release the entitled benefit to the petitioner without any further delay.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-7) but the same is still pending consideration with the



respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-7) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
