Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioner and his family members by visiting the house of the petitioners repeatedly and calling the petitioners to the police station without any reason thereby causing undue harassment and threat to the petitioner and his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners are being harassed by officials of Police Station Dabwali, District Sirsa, who are coming time and again at the house of the petitioners to inquire about their son without any official notice or summons. The petitioners have been threatened that they would be taken to the police station if their son is not brought before the said police officials. Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners filed representation dated 15.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.2,

but till date no action has been taken.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners stated that they would be satisfied, in case, the pending representation (Annexure P-1) is decided by respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arjun Lakhanpal, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice and submitted that he has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 15.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) is decided.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to look into the representation (Annexure P1) and to take appropriate action, if any required, at the earliest.
