1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 05.09.2025 (Annexure P-13) vide which the execution application has been dismissed for non-deposit of the munadi fee.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are decree holders and the case of the petitioners has been dismissed for want of compliance in view of the fact that munadi fee has not been filed by the decree holders-petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are ready to deposit the munadi fee or any other charges which are legally due and thus, seek to withdraw the present petition with liberty to move an appropriate application before the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
