Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Rohit Sharma, D.D.A., SJE Department, H.R. submits that grant-in-aid has been received and the arrears of salary in favour of the petitioners shall be released within a period of 4 weeks from today.

In view of the above, no cause survives in the present petition and the same is thus, disposed of.
