AARADHNA SAWHNEY, J (ORAL)

Petitioner, who is complainant in case FIR No.170 dated 12.06.2025 under Sections 115 (2),191 (3),190, 351(2),353 of BNS registered at P.S Rama Mandi, Jalandhar, has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Section 528 of BNSS, praying therein for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to direct the local police officials to conduct the investigation in the aforesaid case, in accordance with law.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has genuine apprehension that the Investigating Officer is hand in glove with the accused party for the reasons; firstly that the FIR was registered after a delay of one month from the date of incident and, secondly that despite complainant having suffered a fracture on the head, the FIR was lodged under Section 323 IPC. Representation dated 15.07.2025 (Annexure P.2) mentioning entire facts was also moved to the Senior police officials but the same remains undecided till date, hence the present petition.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

5. After considering the respective submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 15.07.2025 (Annexure P.2), within four weeks, in accordance with law. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioners as well.
