Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 08.08.2024, under Sections 420/120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Dugri, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, Punjab.

Vide order dated 19.10.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He has handed over two demand drafts bearing DD No.500681 dated 27.03.2025, amounting to Rs.3,00,000/- and DD No.500682 dated 27.03.2025, amounting to Rs.2,00,000/-; four cheques bearing Cheque No.000988 dated 28.04.2025 amounting to Rs.5,00,000/-, Cheque No.000989 dated 28.05.2025, Cheque No.000990 dated 28.06.2025 and Cheque No.000991 dated 28.07.2025 each amounting to Rs.6,00,000/- to counsel for the

complainant today in the Court who has accepted the same. Photocopies of the same are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that he has received the full and final payment and has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, interim order dated 19.10.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Petition stands allowed.
