(1) Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – The National Highways Authority of India to take a decision on the legal notices dated 14.03.2024, 22.10.2024 & 22.10.2024 (Annexures P-5 to 7) submitted on behalf of the petitioners.
