There is no representation on behalf of the appellant nor any application has been moved to implead the LRs of the deceased- appellant. Perusal of the paper-book would reveal that suit for seeking decree of possession of suit property filed by plaintiff Smt. Kaushlya Devi was dismissed by the trial Court on 08.02.2010 and the appeal filed by the said plaintiff was dismissed by the first Appellate Court on 25.07.2011.
