HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Status report by way of affidavit of Ms. Anupama Malik (HCS), Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estates, Gurugram, on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on specific instructions, submits that the sanction with respect to the amount payable to the petitioners towards compensation has been accorded and even uploaded on the portal. He further assures that the payment along with interest shall be released to the petitioners within two weeks from today.
3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in such eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
