JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 praying for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to immediately look into the representation dated 09.10.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to direct the police officials to take action against the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that despite a complaint being filed with the police by the petitioner/complainant, no action has been taken against the private respondents, who are the in-laws and husband of the petitioner.

3. On the other hand, Mr. P.S. Bhandari, learned AAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Varinder Singh submitted that a DDR on the basis of the complaint made by the petitioner was entered into and thereafter, the complaint was consigned to record because the petitioner/complainant stated that she has

entered into compromise.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the aforesaid submissions made by learned State Counsel, he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same in order to invoke alternate remedy available to the petitioner in accordance with law in case it is so required.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
