**SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)**

1. Numerous prayers have been made in this petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, but counsel for the petitioner has confined the petition to a sole prayer. He submits that as the petitioner has filed an execution petition, Annexure P-5, before the Family Court, Amritsar, and despite issuance of repeated notices, respondent, who is a resident of USA, is not being served, a direction be issued to the Family Court to effect service upon the respondent as per the provisions of the CPC and in compliance of the Hague Convention.

2. This Court finds substance in the prayer made by the petitioner.
