Present petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No. 30 dated 05.02.2022, under Sections 120-B, 409, 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Siwan, District Kaithal and further quashing of order dated 03.05.2024 in CIS No. UCR/656/2024 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kaithal whereby learned Magistrate erred in not accepting the cancellation report.

(2) This Court on 14.01.2025 passed the following order:-

“Learned State counsel shall get instructions about the further investigation, if any, conducted by SHO/Investigating Officer, concerned in compliance of the order dated 03.05.2024 (P-15), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kaithal.

Posted for 03.02.2025.

It is clarified that there is no formal notice of motion in this case.”



(3) Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP-Kuldeep Singh, has apprised the Court that after further investigation of the matter, again final closure report has been prepared and submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction, which is pending consideration for 18.03.2025.

(4) In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition be disposed off with liberty to raise his plea before the Court concerned in accordance with law.

(5) Disposed off accordingly.

(6) Needless to say that in case an occasion so arises, petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
