Petitioner Baljit Singh Gill has filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of appropriate direction to the official respondent to conduct proper, fair, impartial and expeditious investigation in FIR No.134 dated 26.12.2023 registered under Sections 420, 406, 498-A IPC and Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 at P.S. City Zira, District Ferozepur.
