KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to provide easement of rights, i.e. right to passage to the fields of the petitioners, which has been closed on account of acquisition of the petitioner's land, by the Punjab Government, vide notification dated 09.03.1987, for the Tax Collection Centre at Haryana Punjab Border, on G.T. Road, and the petitioners are unable to access their land.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance notice of the petition, Mr. Pardeep Bajaj, DAG, Punjab, waives service and accepts notice qua all the respondents No.1 to 8. He fairly concedes that the instant petition can be disposed of with a mandamus upon the authorities concerned, to decide the representations/legal

notice (Annexures P-2, P-4 and P-12), by passing a speaking order.

4. Considering the consensus between the parties concerned, the instant petition is **disposed of**, with a mandamus upon the competent respondent amongst the respondents, to decide the representations/legal notice (Annexures P-2, P-4 and P-12), by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order/judgment.

5. It goes without saying that the authorities concerned, shall provide an adequate opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, to substantiate their claim, as raised through the representations/legal notice. It also goes without saying that the authorities concerned, shall pass a speaking order, in this regard, within the stipulate period.

6. **Disposed of** accordingly.
