1. The aforesaid case was filed on 25.10.2024 by Ms. Navneet Kaur Waraich, Advocate. The Registry had raised objection on the case file on 28.10.2024.
2. As per Rule 9, Chapter 1, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition, on which objections have been raised by the Registry, is to be taken back by the counsel/party, who filed it, to be refiled within a total period of 40 days. The present case was filed on 25.10.2024 and the Registry raised objections on 28.10.2024, but neither the petitioner nor his counsel ever turned up to receive the present case and file the same after removal of the objections as raised by the office.
3. Office has got listed this case as many such cases are lying in the office in the "incomplete case category", and none has bothered to take further recourse in the matter.
