[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 11.01.2019 passed in CRM-M-752-2019 in case titled as '*Ginny Gujral versus State of Punjab and others*'.

[2] Compliance report by way of affidavit of Mr. Vivek SheelSoni, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), District SAS Nagar has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

[3] Perusal of paragraph 6 of the affidavit reveals that after verifying the complaint as well as documents, which came on record during inquiry, the Station House Officer, Zirakpur has been directed to register FIR No.278 dated 01.07.2020 under Sections 406 and 420 of the IPC at Police Station, Zirakpur.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the

position noted above, he does not press the instant petition and prays for permission to withdraw the same.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
