SANJAY KISHAN KAUL, C.J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of obtaining orders from this Court for the nominee arbitrator of the respondent to be appointed (having appointed their nominee arbitrator) on the panel of three arbitrators to adjudicate the disputes, the petitioner is desirous to have a sole independent arbitrator being appointed by this Court to adjudicate the disputes inter se the parties.

It appears that Mr. S.K. Tandon, Additional District & Sessions Judge (Retired) Delhi was appointed in Arbitration Case No. 108 of 2012 on 25.01.2013 and according to learned counsel for the petitioner, the nature of disputes is similar to the one referred to in those proceedings.

In view of what has been stated aforesaid, Mr. S.K. Tandon, Additional District & Sessions Judge (Retired), Delhi is appointed as the sole arbitrator to enter upon reference and adjudicate the disputes inter se the parties. The venue of arbitration will be at Gurgaon.

The fee of the arbitrator shall be as per the Punjab and Haryana High Court (Arbitrator's Panel and Fee) Rules, 2011.

The petition is accordingly allowed leaving the parties to bear their own costs.

A copy of the order be forwarded to the arbitrator.
