Learned counsel representing respondents submits that the petitioner has been found entitled for regularization on the post of labourer (Shramik) group 'D' w.e.f. 01.10.2003.

Learned counsel for respondents further on instructions submits that letter of regular appointment in this regard shall be issued to the petitioner upon creation of diminishing cadre post along with release of all consequential benefits including the arrears of regular pay as well within a period of four weeks from today.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
