HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for willful non-compliance of order dated 13.01.2016 passed by this Court in CR-191-2016.

Learned counsel for respondent has handed over a post-dated cheque bearing No.000122 amounting to Rs.1,45,000/- towards the balance amount payable to the petitioner and assures that the same would be encashed as and when presented.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule discharged.

However, in case the cheque is dishonoured on producing, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.1,00,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
