Prayer in the present petition is for quashing/setting aside the impugned orders dated 14.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Family Court, Chandigarh in a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act titled as "Sanjay vs. Meenakshi" whereby application filed by the respondent-wife under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act for grant of interim maintenance has been allowed and the petitioner-husband has been directed to pay an amount of Rs.14,000/- per month as maintenance from the date of filing of the application alongwith Rs.25,000/- towards litigation expenses.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act filed by the petitioner before the learned trial Court, has been



withdrawn by the petitioner, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
